2009 Year in Review



Just the Numbers:

- 26 Years serving families in Southern NJ
- 11 Family Room locations
- 673 Kids that stayed at the House while their sibling received treatment
- 4160 Volunteer hours logged at the Family Rooms
- 6832 Volunteer hours logged at the House and events

Serving 18,000 families and counting...

In the last year, RMH of SNJ, with the help of donors and volunteers, we were able to host a total of 797 family stays, representing 496 unique families traveling from 40 other states and 14 countries.

- ✓ Top 2 hospital departments served were Pediatric (50%) and Neonatal (37%)
- ✓ Served 5 hospitals in NJ and PA. Top 3 hospitals served:
 - 45% Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, 25% Shriners Hospital, 24% Cooper University Hospital
- ✓ 83% of stays were 2 weeks or shorter; 16% of stays were longer than 2 weeks
 - Our longest length of stay in 2009 was 211 consecutive nights
- ✓ Dinner was served each night by community groups and Breakfast on the weekends to nourish our families
- ✓ Family Rooms in nine hospitals served 19,500 families
- ✓ Young Friends of RMH, a newly created young professionals' social club, donated \$7,500 to the House
- ✓ Completed a 4,000 sq. ft. construction project that added teen, toddler, and handicapped rooms as well as an expanded dining room and pantry area
 - Five bedrooms were adopted and renovated with kid-friendly themes
